Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers of snow in northeastern Scotland. Wintry showers will also fall today through Northern Ireland, northern England, and North Wales, falling as snow on hills and as sleet and sometimes snow to low levels too. Elsewhere will be dry and sunny, if chilly. Overnight will be dry and cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Mainly fine on Saturday for most of the country, but western Scotland will see snow falling, becoming heavier going into the afternoon. Sunday will see a band of heavy rain moving southeastwards across England and Wales, with further showers in Scotland.
