

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 06 Apr 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It is likely to stay wet and windy across Scotland, with rain easing to scattered heavy showers for Northern Ireland. Rain is expected to spread into Wales and western England during the day, but it should stay dry elsewhere. Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales should become much drier overnight, with rain spreading slowly eastwards across England. Winds should remain light.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Rain should clear the Southeast during Wednesday morning leaving scattered showers for many parts. Dry and sunny weather is expected across Wales and the Southwest though. Outbreaks of rain spreading to Scotland on Thursday should ease but move slowly southwards.
