Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy with showers across Wales and the Midlands. Elsewhere broken cloud and scattered showers, the showers mainly across Northern Ireland, western and northern Scotland. Breezy. Temperatures close to, or slightly above, normal. Overnight rain and strong winds will spread northeast across all areas, with gales developing in many places, becoming locally severe along exposed coasts.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Both days sunny intervals and showers, once heavy rain clears southeast England Thursday morning. Some showers will be heavy, perhaps with thunder, especially across Wales and northwest England. Gales in many places, locally severe across Wales and central England. Feeling colder.
