

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and outbreaks of rain across southern England and south Wales clearing away eastwards this morning, then sunny spells and scattered showers. Some of the showers will be heavy with a risk of thunder, especially in the north. It should feel pleasantly warm in sunshine. Tonight, showers should mostly die out with many places becoming dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Sunshine and a few showers on Monday with some places remaining dry. Outbreaks of rain reaching southwestern areas later on Monday will spread northeastwards to most areas on Tuesday with some of the rain heavy and prolonged. It will become increasingly warm and humid.
