Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain in the far south and southeast will clear by midday. Most areas will be bright or sunny at times, but with cloud increasing in western areas. Showers or periods of rain will spread across Scotland and Northern Ireland later. Sometimes strong southwesterly winds, locally gale force in the northwest of Scotland at first.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Generally cool and unsettled with sunny intervals and blustery showers on Friday and Saturday, some of the showers will be heavy with possible thunder, perhaps locally wintry over northern hills with hail or sleet mixed in. Winds will be west or southwesterly, quite brisk at times.
