

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 10 Jun 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Further showers affecting northeast England and southern Scotland, becoming more widespread later in the morning. Outbreaks of more persistent rain moving across southern parts of the UK, turning heavy in places through the afternoon. Elsewhere, mainly dry with bright spells, although a few showers are still possible.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Outbreaks of rain continuing to affect the south of the UK and central Scotland on Monday, turning heavy at times in the south. Elsewhere, mainly dry with the odd light shower. Rain in the south slowly clearing through Tuesday morning leaving a mixture of sunshine and showers, these heaviest in the west.
