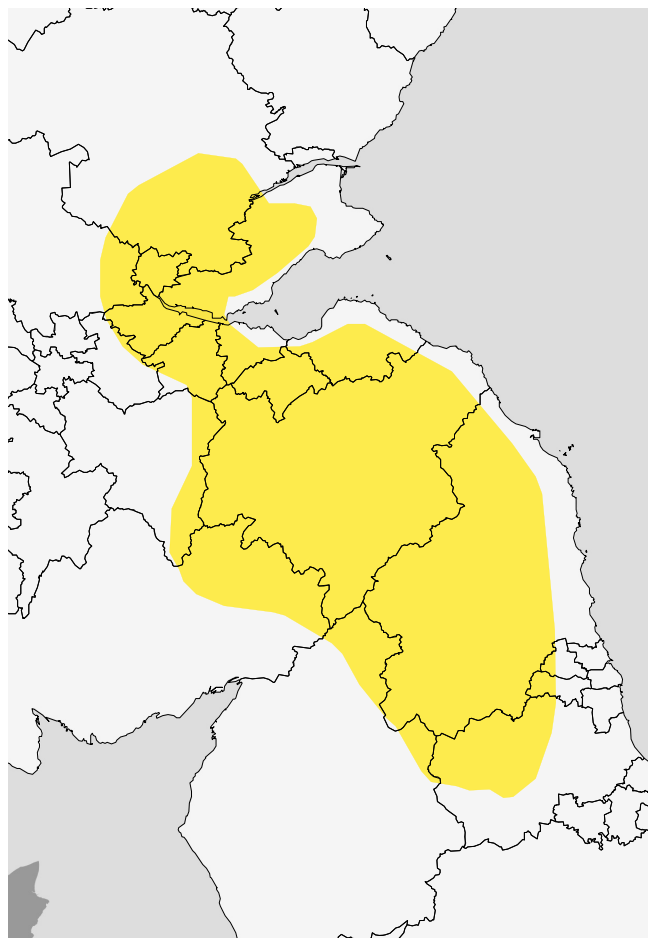

- Ice on some roads, cycle paths and pavements could make accidents and injuries more likely.

Further details

Following clearance of rain, sleet and snow, temperatures will fall below freezing widely.

Where surfaces are not treated and remain wet, icy stretches are possible - this could also happen if run-off from fields washes away treatment.
