

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 05 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Windy, with gales in exposed locations. Rain clearing northeastwards, but tending to persist over Northern Ireland, and over central and southern Scotland, falling as snow over high ground. Squally, heavy showers across England and Wales, locally thundery. Rain and showers tending to mostly clear overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be a drier day for many, with lighter winds and sunny periods. On Thursday, rather wet and windy across many northern areas at first, but with the rain generally moving away eastwards. Southern areas are likely to stay mostly cloudy, mild and damp after a wet start in the east.
