Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Most of Britain dry with good sunny periods. Rain spreading into northwest Scotland late in the afternoon, but making little eastwards progress overnight. Mostly very warm but hot inland in the south, cooler near exposed coasts. Mainly dry overnight, just a small risk of a few showers spreading across southwest England by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain slow moving over northwest Scotland on Sunday. Elsewhere, dry and sunny at first but scattered heavy showers or thunderstorms developing, mostly over high ground of Wales, northern England and Scotland. Monday, sunny spells and scattered thundery showers, in the west and north. Very warm or hot.
