Headline:

Sunny spells but cold, with wintry showers near north-facing coasts.

Today:

Sunny spells, but it will be cold. Blustery showers, mostly of hail or snow, will affect coastal areas exposed to the cold, gusty northerly winds.

Tonight:

Many areas will be clear and frosty, but blustery showers of snow or hail will continue to affect northern areas, and many western coastal areas too.

Outlook for Thursday:

Remaining cold, with wintry showers in exposed coastal areas.
