Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Northern Scotland will be cloudy with outbreaks of rain. Elsewhere,  
there will be sunny spells, with most places seeing more sunshine  
than on recent days. However, there will also be showers, some of  
these heavy and prolonged with hail, thunder and gusty winds. It will  
be generally mild, but northern Scotland will remain cold.

Tonight, showers will become confined to northern and western areas,  
many eastern areas becoming dry. It will be windy in the south.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

It will remain unsettled with further rain or showers, but with some  
sunny spells in between. It will turn colder as winds turn into the  
north.
