

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 02 Feb 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold and frosty start for many, with icy patches in southeast. Staying mostly dry with some sunny spells but cloud generally increasing. Some wintry showers, mainly in coastal areas. Persistent snow pushing south over northern Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight leading to fresh accumulations, whilst snow showers pushing inland over parts of eastern England. A frost forming again.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Snow across Scotland and Northern Ireland dying out, further snow showers moving into the far north Tuesday. Snow showers affecting parts of the east coast on both days, and staying dry elsewhere. Cold and frosty, but less so in northwest Wednesday.
