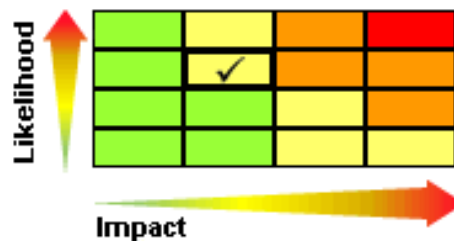
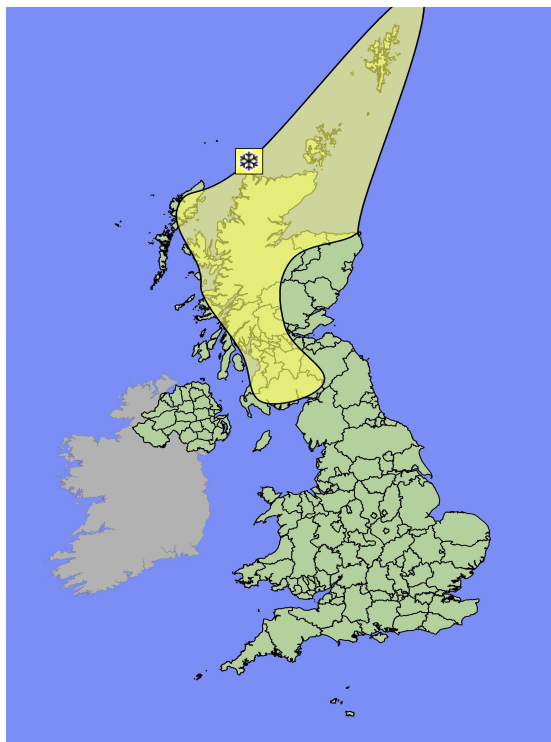




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Snow showers will be more frequent across higher ground in Western Scotland with an additional 5 to 10cm possible above 100m or so, and 2 to 5cm at lower levels.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Snow**

Valid from **10:55 on Mon, 05th Dec 2011** until **23:59 on Mon, 05th Dec 2011**

Further wintry showers will affect Northern Western and Central Scotland this afternoon and this evening. Icy stretches are likely to form on untreated surfaces by evening.

The public should be aware that this could lead to travel disruption in places.
