Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sleet or snow across central areas will sink south, becoming light and patchy by afternoon. Snow showers will push inland with rain moving into southwest England. Windy and bitterly cold for most. Overnight, rain in the southwest will turn to snow and will push across other southern counties. It will be bitterly cold with frost, ice and further snow showers.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Snow will continue to affect some southern counties through Monday giving further accumulations. Drier elsewhere but with snow showers in places. Brighter spells and scattered snow showers will continue into Tuesday. Staying bitterly cold with widespread frost and ice overnight.
