

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 09 May 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A day of scattered cloud and sunny intervals for most places, although cloud will become thicker and more extensive at times with a possibility of light rain or drizzle. Southern England will start generally cloudier with outbreaks of rain, but this should clear away to the south by midday, leaving a somewhat brighter afternoon.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Scotland generally cloudy on Monday with outbreaks of light rain, perhaps sleet, becoming widespread. Elsewhere, patchy cloud and some sunny intervals but cloud thickening up at times to bring outbreaks of rain. On Tuesday, many places will stay dry, but showers are likely in the northwest.
