Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunshine and scattered showers today, with the heaviest and most frequent showers across southern and western areas. Many eastern parts though staying largely dry and seeing the best of the sunshine. Overnight the scattered showers will spread east, with a risk of hail and thunder. Some clearer spells developing in between, giving the risk of the odd icy patch.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be another day of sunny spells and showers, and the showers are likely to be more widespread, affecting eastern as well as western parts. Apart from a few early showers, Tuesday will be a largely fine and dry day.
