

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Bitterly cold and breezy across the south and east of England, with a mix of sunshine and occasional sleet or snow showers. Cold elsewhere too, but mainly fine and sunny with light winds. Dry and clear across most parts tonight, with a widespread hard frost, although rain and hill snow will spread southeastwards across Scotland later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Generally fine but very cold on Tuesday across England, Wales and Northern Ireland, but breezy with outbreaks of rain or sleet across Scotland. Cold and sleety across central and northern England and Wales on Wednesday, while brighter in the north and far south.
