

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 01 May 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A band of rain will move southeast across the UK, becoming very light and patchy by the time it reaches southeast England and East Anglia this evening. Sunshine and showers will follow across Northern Ireland and Scotland today, showers mostly dying away overnight. Becoming warm across East Anglia and southeast England, while gales develop across the far northwest of Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Saturday showers or longer spells of rain across western, northern and central Scotland. Elsewhere mainly dry with sunny spells, only isolated showers. Sunday any early rain across southern England soon clearing. Then southwest England dry, otherwise sunshine and scattered showers.
