

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A dry and chilly start for much of England and Wales but scattered showers, already in Northern Ireland and Scotland, will spread eastwards to most areas, locally heavy with hail or thunder. Drier and sunnier weather will then move into Scotland and Northern Ireland through the day. Windy in places, particularly southwest England and Wales.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Generally settled but fairly cloudy, with a few light wintry showers in southeast England on both days and some rain and hill snow pushing into northern areas on Tuesday afternoon. Becoming rather cold in many parts, especially overnight, with frost forming under any clear skies.
