Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain in southwestern parts of the United Kingdom spreads northeastwards during the day, turning to sleet and snow over many parts of Wales, the Midlands, northern and eastern England and central and southern Scotland. It continues to spread northwards into northern Scotland overnight with many western and central parts becoming dry but staying cloudy.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Further rain will affect many parts of the UK on Thursday, turning to snow over hills as it spreads northwards. It will become windy too, especially in western parts. Rain clears away northeastwards on Friday with many southern and western places becoming dry.
