

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of the north and west will have some rain at times, the rain often heavy and prolonged in western Scotland but generally more patchy elsewhere. Central, southern and eastern England will be dry and bright. Tonight rain in the north and west will tend to ease. Most of central and southern England will remain dry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be generally rather cloudy with a few showers, although most places will remain dry. On Thursday most areas will be dry with sunny spells, although rain will move into northern Scotland. Patchy mist and fog will take a while to disperse.
