

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered showers and sunny spells at first, showers heaviest and most frequent towards the north and west of the UK. More persistent rain will reach Northern Ireland, Wales and northwest England in the afternoon, spreading eastwards overnight across much of England. Scattered showers will continue over western Scotland but southeastern Britain should have drier spells. Feeling cool in the wind.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Outbreaks of rain will continue northeastwards on Thursday and Friday, becoming confined to the north and west of the UK. Drier and clearer weather should develop across southeastern Britain by Friday, where it will be warm. Winds will remain brisk.
