

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 20 Nov 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain in the west, locally heavy, slowly clearing northwest areas, but moving eastwards across all but the extreme southeast. A mild but windy day with the risk of severe gales in the far northwest later. Overnight, further outbreaks of rain in the south and east, heavy and persistent in places. Scattered showers across northwest Scotland. Otherwise, cloudy but mainly dry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Rain or showers gradually clearing on Wednesday morning, becoming largely dry and bright by afternoon. On Thursday, very windy in the north and west, with heavy rain spreading across western areas during the day. Largely dry and bright further east.
