Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain, heavy at times, in the far SW will spread gradually northeast,
reaching the rest of Wales, and many central and southern areas this
afternoon as well as the Irish Borders. Further north; after the slow
clearance of fog in Scotland/N England, a day of bright or sunny
intervals is expected, with showers, mainly near coasts.
Tonight, rain will continue across Wales and many central areas with
heavy, possibly thundery showers towards south coast. Rain or showers
developing over N Isles and E Scotland. Rather windy generally.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Windy with rain or showers initially, but dry/ fine for a time on
Saturday.
