Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of sleet or snow across northern England and Scotland dying away.
Cloud and rain spreading into the southwest with a risk of some sleet over the moors. Eastern Scotland remaining showery with further snow accumulations in places. Winds increasing around the southwest coasts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday a band of cloud and rain spreads across all parts of England and Wales, with snow across higher ground of Wales and Northern England, Scotland mostly dry with sunshine in the west and a few showers in the east. Sunday remains unsettled with a further band of rain and strong winds spreading across all parts.
