Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and patchy rain in Wales and Southwest England at first will gradually clear with all parts then having bright or sunny intervals, with just a few showers. Most parts will be dry overnight, although it is likely to turn misty in some rural parts with patchy fog forming.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
England and Wales will be dry on both Thursday and Friday with some sunshine after the clearance of overnight mist and fog. Outbreaks of rain will spread southwards into Scotland and Northern Ireland on Thursday, but this should become light and patchy on Friday.
