Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A cloudy start for many parts, especially in the south, with some breaks in western areas allowing bright or sunny intervals and these developing more widely elsewhere through the day. Wintry showers will affect many eastern and some central areas. Cold generally, with brisk northeasterly winds in the south.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Largely dry with some sunny periods for western areas. Eastern parts cloudier with occasional snow showers, these likely to give some significant accumulations in the far southeast. Further rain, sleet or snow moving south across Scotland on Thursday. Staying cold on both days with widespread overnight frosts.
