Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and outbreaks of showery rain over the United Kingdom will gradually ease away eastwards during today, with most parts becoming dry with plenty of bright or sunny spells developing. Chilly north or northwesterly winds will ease through the day, and it will turn frosty in the evening.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be dry and sunny for most after widespread early frosts although cloud and patchy rain will arrive in the far northwest early, and other northwestern parts by evening. The cloud will extend throughout on Wednesday though central and eastern parts will stay dry.
