

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will be fine and sunny today with very warm temperatures. It will be cloudier across the northwest of Scotland with rain later. Isolated thunderstorms may affect the southwest of England too with this risk continuing overnight. Away from northern Scotland, it will be stay dry elsewhere.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Remaining damp across northwest Scotland on Friday but with largely fine conditions elsewhere. As it turns increasingly humid, isolated thunderstorms may develop across the south and by evening, a thundery rainband will push north across England and Wales. Rain will persist across central parts on Saturday but it will be drier elsewhere.
