Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, Northern Ireland, cloudy, rain at times, most of the rain across the west and far north of Scotland, eastern parts often drier and brighter. England and Wales mainly dry, bright or sunny spells. Tonight, rain and drizzle across the west and far north of Scotland. Mainly dry elsewhere, variable cloud, patchy mist and fog forming under clear skies.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday, further spells of rain across western Scotland and later Northern Ireland, but eastern Scotland and much of England and Wales dry, variable amounts of cloud, bright or sunny spells. Becoming cooler Saturday with sunny periods, then cold overnight.
