Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Some occasionally heavy rain will affect Northern Ireland this morning and Scotland and northern England this afternoon and this evening. Showers will follow from the west. Elsewhere it will be dry and bright after a damp, locally foggy start, but rain will reach west Wales by the afternoon and move east across England, clearing Kent around dawn.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Outbreaks of rain will die out across northern Scotland on Thursday and most places will have a dry day with some pleasant spells of sunshine. Dry for much of Friday but becoming wet and windy later in the far northwest.
