

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Low cloud in eastern parts will burn back to the coast this morning, then most parts will have unbroken sunshine, and again it will be warm, particularly in shelter from the easterly wind which will be particularly noticeable in the south . Low cloud will spread back into many central and eastern parts overnight, while the west stays clear.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Low cloud could take a while to clear back to the east-coast tomorrow but after it does, most will enjoy another fine day with gentle northeasterly winds. It's looking similar for Friday with most places enjoying another dry and sunny day.
