

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry day for much of the country, although with a good deal of cloud around. This cloud could produce a little light rain or drizzle in places, parts of southern Scotland and northern England most prone. Despite the cloud some sunshine is expected, mainly across central Scotland. Light winds. Remaining mostly dry overnight with a good deal of cloud.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A little rain affecting Northern Ireland later on Monday. Elsewhere, generally dry but fairly cloudy conditions are expected with only limited bright or sunny spells. Becoming much more unsettled on Tuesday with rain moving across all parts during the day.
