

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 05 Jun 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain across much of Scotland will gradually ease through the day, although  
coasts in the east will continue to be plagued by extensive low cloud.  
Elsewhere, a brighter and much warmer day than on Wednesday, although with the  
risk of a few showers. Remaining quite cloudy in the north tonight, but clear  
and chilly further south.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Many areas will see warm sunshine on Friday, although breezy with a risk of  
showers in the far southwest and also across northern Scotland. Becoming  
increasingly humid into Saturday, especially further east, with heavy, thundery  
rain moving northeastwards across many areas through the day.
