

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Saturday 01 May 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain, locally heavy and persistent, should slowly clear from southeastern England during the day but may linger across the far southeast until the evening. Elsewhere, bright spells and the odd light shower or spot of drizzle are expected, with the brightest conditions in far western Wales and Northern Ireland. Winds will be brisk northeasterlies and it will feel much colder.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A mixture of scattered showers and sunny spells on Monday with the brightest conditions in far western parts of the UK. Rain may spread to Scotland on Tuesday, but it should be cloudy and mainly dry elsewhere. Staying rather chilly.
