Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Outbreaks of rain, locally heavy, will continue across northern England and southern Scotland, slowly edging away northeastwards. Other areas, mostly dry with sunny spells, just a few scattered showers towards the west. There will be quite strong northwesterly winds, these reaching gale force around Irish Sea coasts and over the Pennines, and making it feel rather colder than of late.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A sunny start in the east Saturday, but then rain spreading to all areas. Northern areas see a return to sunshine and scattered showers at times, but the south staying cloudy and wet for much of the weekend. Average temperatures.
