Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Christmas Eve will be mostly cloudy and mild across England and Wales with patches of drizzle mainly on western hills. Persistent and, at times, heavy rain across Scotland will move into Northern Ireland and northern England later. Elsewhere, it will stay mostly dry and mild overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Christmas Day will see occasionally squally, heavy rain effect southern Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales, and the Southwest. Rain will turn to snow over the hills of Scotland and northern England. It will be mild and cloudy across the Southeast; and, cold and showery across north Scotland. Mostly drier and brighter on Boxing Day.
