

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and scattered showers will continue in many parts, with some showers becoming heavy and perhaps thundery. In northern Scotland and southeastern England these showers should be fewer and further between, giving longer brighter spells. By evening, showers should become largely confined to the southwest, although further showers should develop in northern UK overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday, many will see further heavy and perhaps thundery showers. Sunny spells will be most prevalent in the drier Southeast, while many parts of northern UK will be cloudier. Similar conditions are expected on Monday, but with showers chiefly affecting the east.
