Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scotland and northern England should see a fine day, with plenty of sunshine, although patches of freezing fog will persist in places. Along with areas of freezing fog, generally more cloud to the south, thick enough for the odd snow flurry, but conditions brightening up from the east through the day. Increasingly cold in the south through the afternoon.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Away from Northern Ireland and western Scotland, where it will be breezy with rain at times, the cold spell will continue, with some severe overnight frosts likely. Generally becoming somewhat cloudier again across England and Wales, with mainly light winds here.
