Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Most places will start dull. There will be rain in many areas at first, some heavy, though the more persistent rain across southeast England will clear eastwards. Rain further north will be more showery, but some heavy, perhaps thundery downpours are likely across parts of the north and east. Western areas will become brighter and dry with some warm spells of sunshine.
Tonight, thundery showers in the east clearing, then most places will be dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Scotland and Northern Ireland will be cloudy with rain at times, especially in the north and west. England and Wales will be mostly dry with some spells of warm sunshine.
