Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Patchy fog, dense in some places this morning may be slow to clear. Many parts should have a dry day however with sunny periods after a locally frosty start. Occasional showers are expected, these mostly in the north and east, wintry at times. Temperatures generally near or rather below average.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

After a widespread, sharp overnight frost, Tuesday should be another mostly dry, rather cold day with sunny periods. A scattering of wintry showers, mainly in the east. Dry again for most on Wednesday but further wintry showers in the northeast and outbreaks of rain and hill snow in the southwest.
