Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many places starting bright, with scattered heavy showers soon developing during the morning, particularly in northern and western parts, with the best dry weather and sunshine expected towards the southeast. The brisk southerly wind will be most noticeable over western Britain and exposed parts of Northern Ireland, with some gusting likely near showers.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Becoming cooler, with temperatures returning to around average for the time of year, with sunshine, showers and southwesterly winds. The main focus of these showers will be towards the breezier northwest, with the driest weather continuing towards the south and east.
