Headline:

Today:

Many places dry with sunny spells after a frosty start. Showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland, turning to snow in the north later. Southern England cloudier, some patchy rain for the southwest.

Tonight:

Sleet or snow showers spreading south to many northern areas. Elsewhere, clear and frosty. Patchy freezing fog.

Outlook for Monday:

Sunny spells and snow showers. Significant snowfall for some northern areas.
