

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 15 Oct 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A chilly start with localised fog slow to clear from the north and west. Then mainly dry with sunny spells. Cloudier in the south and east with scattered showers, the heaviest likely in the southeast with a brisk, chilly north-easterly breeze too. Turning cold overnight with localised patches of fog and frost away from the cloudier, breezier southeast.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Best conditions in the northwest where it'll be fine, dry with sunny spells on both days once any fog clears. Cloudier elsewhere with some showers, especially in the southeast where it will be breezy. Cold overnight with some fog and frost possible.
