Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of the UK will be dry with a mixture of sunny spells and scattered cloud developing during the day. Just a chance of some isolated light showers developing across northern Scotland. Feeling warm again across most parts, especially in the south. Overnight should remain fine and dry everywhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will become a little more unsettled through the weekend with an increased chance of showers, especially across Northern Ireland and Scotland, and parts of Wales and northwest England. However, staying very warm for most of England and Wales, perhaps even locally hot in the southeast during Sunday.
