Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
An icy start to the day in places, especially across the southeastern quarter of England where there will also be some snow showers. Away from the southeast it will be generally dry but cold with sunny spells, and a widespread frost will return later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
After a very cold start Tuesday will be dry across England and Wales with sunny spells. However parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland will have a little rain and snow. Wednesday will be cold, dry and bright in the south and west but there will be a little rain or snow in the north and east.
