Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Tuesday:-Cloudy with outbreaks of rain, some heavy. Southern parts starting dry, but rain spreading from northwest. Brighter weather, with showers, following to all but far southeast. Temperatures near normal, feeling colder in the wind.
Tuesday evening/night:-Rain soon clearing southeastern England. Showers continuing Northwest Scotland, with outbreaks of light rain spreading to N.Ireland later. Elsewhere becoming dry with clear skies and turning chilly.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Further rain spreading across northern parts on Wednesday. Brighter in south, some rain later. Rain in south clearing early Thursday. Then all parts seeing sunny spells and showers, these heavy in the north. Windy with near normal temperatures.
