Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
The south and southeast will be cloudy with a little rain today. Other areas will see bright spells but with scattered showers too, especially across the Scottish borders and northern England. Rain will finally clear the southeast tonight with showers elsewhere dying out. Most places will then be dry and chilly but rain is expected in the west later.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Brisk winds and rain spreading to most parts on Monday with rain becoming heavy in places. Snow is likely over high ground in Scotland for a time. Staying windy on Tuesday when further showers or outbreaks of rain are expected.
