

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 26 Jan 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain and strong winds sweeping east, falling as hill snow at times in the north. Gales to severe gales in the north and west. Sunshine and blustery showers later, with snow over northern hills. Further persistent hill snow for high ground of Scotland overnight. Elsewhere, wintry showers, possibly falling as snow to low levels in southern parts at times.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Turning colder across all areas and remaining unsettled throughout with showers or longer spells of rain that may turn wintry in places, especially over northern hills. Winds will be strong, particularly towards the north and west with coastal gales likely.
