

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 07 Dec 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will clear to the southeast by early afternoon leaving all parts with sunny spells and blustery showers, these heaviest, most frequent and wintry across northern and western Britain. Substantial snowfall is expected across the Scottish mountains. Clear spells and wintry showers will continue overnight, with snow to low levels in the north. Patchy frosty and icy stretches are likely.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Wintry showers should become less frequent during Monday and there will be sunshine for many but it will be cold with strong northwesterly winds. Very windy on Tuesday too but milder for a time as rain sweeps across the UK.
